Membership Information

To become a full member, private firms or institutions must work professionally in service design. There are two types of full membership: scientific members and service design agencies.

Scientific Members

Scientific members are academic institutions conducting research and instruction in service design. Scientific members initially receive an associated (partial) membership. Shortly before the yearly service design conference, scientific members have the chance to receive a full membership, provided they can demonstrate to SDN representatives their institution's activities in service design research and instruction.

Service Design Agencies

Service design agencies are firms that do professional service design projects together with commercial, public, or non-profit organizations.

Service design agencies initially receive an associated (partial) membership. Shortly before the yearly service design conference, service design agencies have the chance to receive a full membership, provided they can demonstrate to SDN representatives their firm's activities in service design.

Private Members

Anyone interested in service design can become a private member. Private membership is free and also comes with a newsletter subscription.

Membership Fee

The basic membership fee is 500 EUR per year. Membership always begins on January 1 and ends on December 31 of the respective membership year, regardless when the membership is purchased.

If you become a member as from 1. December 2009 you are paying the membership fee of 500 Euro and getting membership for 2010 starting the 1st of December 2009.

After your registration is received, you will be sent an invoice for the membership fee.
