

Agreement for Publication and Transfer of Copyrights

Dear Author,

The following “Agreement for Publication and Transfer of Copyrights” was prepared as a model for agreement between Service Design Network gmbH (publisher of Touchpoint, the Journal of Service Design) and the author of an article or other contribution to the Journal. The Agreement is primarily for use by journals published Internationally.

This Agreement reflects the position that the author transfers the copyright of the article to SDN, as publisher, to publish the article in various formats and to license the publication of the article through third-party. The Agreement also permits SDN to publish the article online with or without restrictions on access.

The author has explicit rights to use their article in future research, teaching, and other projects, which are non-profit related. The author may publish the article in another journal, in a book, or by other means with the specific permission of SDN.

Agreement for Publication and Transfer of Copyrights

ARTICLE PUBLISHING AGREEMENT - COPYRIGHT ASSIGNMENT

Assignment of Copyright

1. In consideration of the publication of the Author's Article and subject to the provisions of the accompanying publishing agreement information form, the author assigns to Service Design Network gGmbH ("SDN"), with full title guarantee, all rights of copyright and related rights in said Article. So that there is no doubt, this assignment includes the assignment of the rights to publish, reproduce, distribute, display and store the Article worldwide in all forms, formats and media now known or as developed in the future, including print, electronic and digital forms, to translate the Article into other languages, create adaptations, summaries or extracts of the Article or other derivative works based on the Article shall apply in these respects, and to sub-licence all such rights to others. In the event the Article is not accepted and published by SDN or is withdrawn by the Author before acceptance by SDN, the assignment of copyright set out in this agreement shall cease to be effective and all rights assigned by the Author to SDN in relation to the Article shall revert to the Author.

Publisher Responsibilities

2. SDN shall prepare and publish the Author's Article for the Journal. SDN reserves the right to make such editorial changes as may be necessary to make the Article suitable for publication, or as SDN reasonably considers necessary to avoid infringing third party rights or law; and SDN reserves the right not to proceed with publication for whatever reason.

Author Rights

3. The Author hereby asserts his/her moral rights to be identified as the author of the Article according to German copyright law.

4. The Author is permitted to use the material if using the Article in future research, teaching, and other projects. These are rights that are personal to the Author and cannot be transferred by the Author to anyone else. The Author may publish the Article in another journal, in a book, or by other means only with the specific written permission of SDN.

5. **The Author is not allowed to publish his article on his personal or his institution's website (in the body of the website (HTML) nor to download).** The author is invited to refer to the link to the article published on the SDN website with full acknowledgement of the references:

With the link to the article must appear:

- from which issue of Touchpoint the article is taken (Touchpoint Vol. x No. x - Title)
- "Touchpoint, the Journal of Service Design is published by Service Design Network"

Author Warranties

6. The Author hereby warrants that he/she has secured the necessary written permission from the appropriate copyright owner or authorities for the reproduction in the Article and in the Journal of any text, illustration, or other material. The Author warrant that, apart from any such third party copyright material included in the Article, the Article is his/her original work, and does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any other person or entity and cannot be construed as plagiarising any other published work. The Author further warrant that the Article is not currently under submission to, nor is under consideration by nor has been accepted by any other journal or publication, nor has been previously assigned or licenced by the Author to any third party. Without prejudice to the provisions of Clause 3 above, the Author undertakes that the fully reference-linked version of scholarly record will not be published elsewhere without SDN's prior written consent.

7. In addition, the Author warrants that the Article contains no statement that is abusive, defamatory, libellous, obscene, fraudulent, nor in any way infringes the rights of others, nor is in any other way unlawful or in violation of applicable laws.

8. The Author warrants that, wherever possible and appropriate, any patient, client or participant in any research or clinical experiment or study who is mentioned in the Article has given consent to the inclusion of material pertaining to themselves, and that they acknowledge that they cannot be identified via the Article and that the Author will not identify them in any way.

9. The Author warrant that he/she shall include in the text of the Article appropriate warnings concerning any particular hazards that may be involved in carrying out experiments or procedures described in the Article or involved in instructions, materials, or formulae in the Article, and shall mention explicitly any relevant safety precautions, and give, if an accepted code of practice is relevant, a reference to the relevant standard or code.

10. The Author undertakes that he/she will keep SDN and our affiliates indemnified in full against all loss, damages, injury, costs and expenses (including legal and other professional fees and expenses) awarded against or incurred or paid by SDN as a result of his/her breach of the warranties given in this agreement.

11. If the Article was prepared jointly with other authors, the Author warrants that he/she has been authorised by all co-authors to sign this Agreement as agent on their behalf, and to agree on their behalf the order of names in the publication of the Article. The Author shall notify SDN in writing of the names of any such co-owners.

Governing Law

This agreement (and any dispute, proceeding, claim or controversy in relation to it) is subject to German law. It may only be amended by a document signed by both parties.

AGREEMENT IN RELATION TO COPYRIGHT OF AN ARTICLE WRITTEN FOR TOUCHPOINT JOURNAL (Published by Service Design Network gGmbH)

In order to ensure both the widest dissemination and protection of material published in SDN's Journal, SDN asks Authors to transfer to the Publisher, SDN, the rights of copyright in the Articles they contribute. This enables SDN to ensure protection against infringement. The transfer of copyright must be clearly stated in writing.
